



Operation SafeHouse Group Volunteers

Activities that group volunteers can do with the clients:

- Pizza Party
- Group games-Group volunteers can spend time with the youth while playing games such as Pictionary, Charades and Taboo.
- Arts and crafts-Group volunteers can share their artistic side with the youth by doing art classes such painting, drawing, jewelry making and vision board.
- Educational Presentation-Groups can facilitate workshops on subjects such as college preparation and financial planning.
- Cooking or baking-Groups can interact with the youth while teaching them how cook a meal or bake a tasty treat.
- Sports-Groups can play basketball or volleyball with the youth on our on-site basketball court.
- Exercise classes such as Yoga, Zumba and other exercise dance.

Other activities group volunteers can do to support SafeHouse:

- Gardening may include planting our SafeHouse garden or pulling weeds. Light lifting involved.
- Shelter maintenance may include painting, adopting a room and decorating it, if qualified light repairs throughout the shelter. Some physical activity if painting. Light to medium lifting.
- Food drive – Groups can collect non-perishable food items for our shelter.
- Paper good drive – Groups can collect paper goods such as toilet paper, paper towels, Kleenex, paper plates, etc.
- Shelter uniform drive - Groups can collect uniforms for our emergency shelter, such as black or grey sweats or grey or black t-shirts in all sizes.
- Stuff the Bus Fundraiser in November – Sorting boxes of donations, assisting in unloading the bus, assisting in organizing the storage sheds. Light to heavy lifting involved.
