Where Change Begins

Operation SafeHouse's twenty-one day program provides immediate help to youth ages 11-17 who are experiencing emergency situations. SafeHouse is open twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week to assist youth and families in crisis. Services include: Individual, group, and family counseling, life skills, substance abuse education, anti-human trafficking program, family support services, parenting classes, anger management, continuing on-site education and aftercare.

With programs in both Riverside and the Coachella Valley, Operation SafeHouse is well equipped to help runaway, homeless and other youth in crisis. Teens who don't know where else to go are always welcome at SafeHouse – all they have to do is show up at our door or a designated Safe Place site.

TRANSITIONAL LIVING PROGRAM

Building Futures and Permanency

Operation SafeHouse's Main Street Transitional Living Program is a 15 unit-apartment complex located in proximity to Riverside City College and downtown Riverside. Main Street offers homeless young adults, ages 18-21, a place to learn the skills they need to make the transition from homelessness to successful independent adulthood. While in our program youth are given individualized case management and therapy that is designed specifically to meet every individual's needs and includes; life skills, financial literacy, employment assistance, and educational advancement. Young adults in this program are encouraged to start building their futures and are provided with the tools they need to be successful and live self-sufficiently.

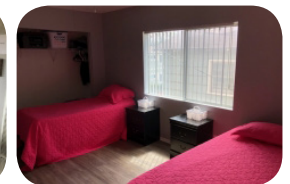
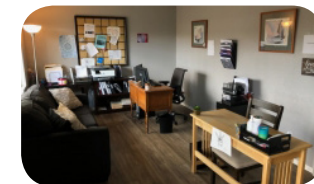
YOUNG ADULT EMERGENCY SERVICES

Restoring Dignity and Well-Being

Operation SafeHouse's Main S.T.A.Y. Program is a 30-day program that provides older homeless youth ages 18-24 with assistance in their journey from the streets into shelter and/or permanent housing.

Once the youth enters the Main S.T.A.Y. Program, they have access to a Case Manager who will help them create an individualized service plan, obtain medical and dental services, necessary documentation, access to secondary education, life skills training, financial literacy, and employment. Clinicians provide individualized mental health counseling to restore the youth's dignity, resiliency and well-being.

COGNITIVE BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS FOR TRAUMA IN SCHOOL (CBITS) - For youth ages 10-15 - Trauma focused treatment (10 week program) - Individual and Group sessions available

STRESS AND YOUR MOOD (SAYM) - For Transitional Aged Youth ages 16-25 - Stress and/or Depression focused treatment (12 week program) - Individual and Group sessions available

SEEKING SAFETY - For Transitional Aged Youth ages 16-25 - PTSD and Substance Abuse focused treatment (8 week program) - Individual and Group sessions available

PEER TO PEER - CUP OF HAPPY - For Transitional Aged Youth ages 16-25 - C.A.S.T. (Coping and Support Training) - Mentoring - Speaker's Bureau - Directing Change - LGBTQ+ Support Group
